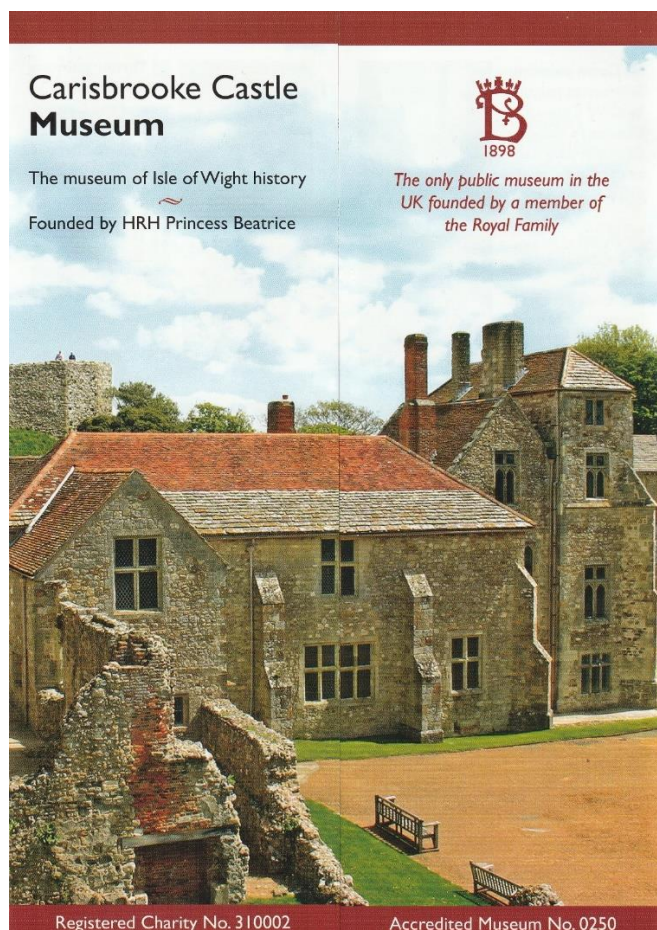


We are pleased to announce that we will be running a trip to Carisbrooke Castle on the Isle of Wight on **Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> May 2024**



The coach will start from Emsworth at 08:30 and then pick-up at Southampton University Highfield Campus by 09:30 to cross to the island on the Red Funnel sailing from Southampton at 11:00. We will return on a ferry at about 15:00 to drop off at Southampton University by 16:30 and Emsworth by about 17:30. Once at the museum we will receive a talk from Nicholas Minns one of our members who is a guide at the museum. The talk will focus on the work of Sir John Milne FRS and we can see a working seismograph. We can then explore the castle and lunch will be available at the Eight Bells in Carisbrooke.
