RSC Faraday Division and SACI will run a residential workshop on Catalysis for Sustainable Chemistry for African scientists and engineers to be held at Wits University in Johannesburg, South Africa on 16-19 November 2011. The workshop will cover both experimental and computational methods emphasizing the important areas of future catalysis research.

Topics to be covered during the lectures and poster presentations will be:

- **water**
- **energy**
- **food technologies**
- **sustainable technologies**

Financial support will be provided for up to 25 African participants covering travel and accommodation expenses and most meals. The workshop is open to up to 10 South African scientists/engineers and up to 15 scientists/engineers from the rest of Africa. Special consideration will be given to early career academics or graduate students of chemistry/chemical engineering applications.
