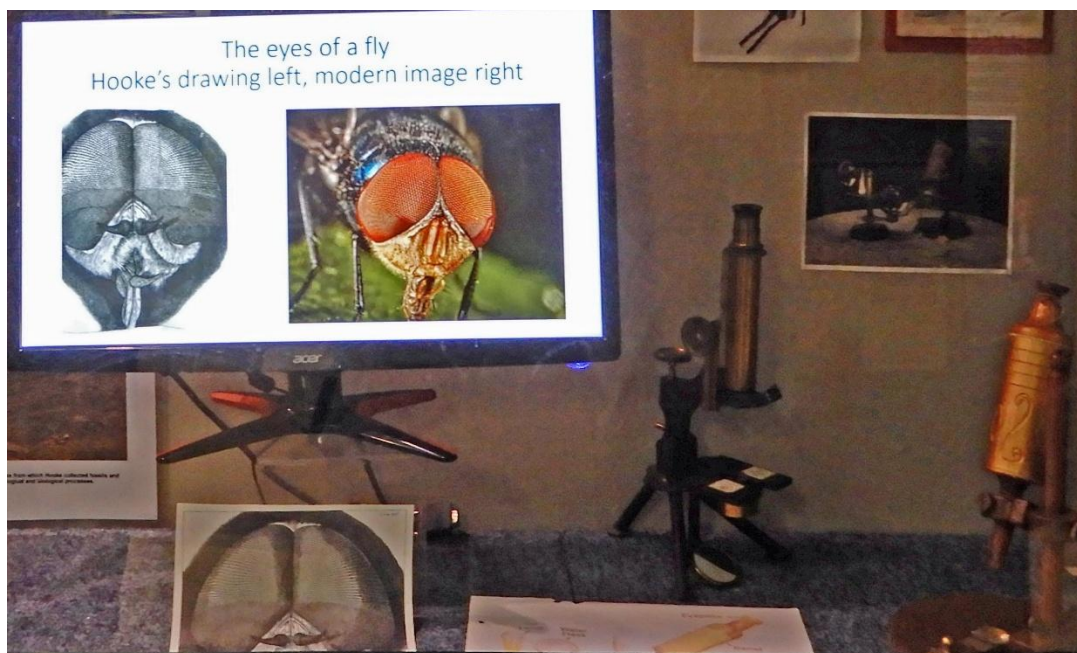


We are pleased to announce that we will be running a trip to The Robert Hooke Museum on the Isle of Wight on **Saturday 10th May 2025**



The coach will pick-up at Emsworth bus stop opposite the King's Arms at 08:30 hrs and will travel to the University of Southampton, Highfield Campus, Unilinc Bus Terminal and will pick-up there between 10:45 hrs and 11:00 hrs. It will then proceed to the Red Funnel Ferry Port to board the 12:00 hrs sailing to Cowes this will also be a pick-up point. We will aim to be at the museum by 14:00 hrs for a look around and lecture by a member of the Robert Hooke Society about the life of Robert Hooke FRS and his connection to the Isle of Wight. There will also be a small magic show for younger children instead of the lecture. The museum is located in the planetarium at Fort Victoria close to Yarmouth. There is a café there and another café about 200 metres along the beach. A packed lunch is recommended although food and drink will be available at the cafes. We will leave the museum by 16:30 to catch the 18:00 ferry back to Southampton. Drop off at the Highfield campus should be by 19:30 and final drop off at Emsworth by 20:30.

Health & Safety

It is important that all children are under supervision of a responsible adult at all times. The identified hazards of this trip are dangerous tidal currents making the sea there unfit for bathing. There is also an elevated walkway along the fort wall, this presents a risk of a fall from height for small children.
