

Lilly

BY ROAD...

From London and M3 - take M3 to junction 3, signposted A322 to Bracknell and Guildford. Take A322 towards Bracknell and the A30, go under the A30 and take the first slip road on your left signposted A30 to London and Staines. Follow the A30 towards London for approximately ½ mile, take left turn onto the B3020, signposted to Sunninghill. Lilly Research Centre is on the left, about 100 yards from the junction B3020/A30.

From the West, M4/junction 10 - take the A329(M) to Bracknell, follow the A322 signs to Bagshot. Go under the A30, take the slip road immediately on your left to Sunningdale. At the roundabout, turn right (London and Staines). Follow the A30 towards London for approximately ½ mile, take left turn onto the B3020, signposted to Sunninghill.

Lilly Research Centre is on the left, about 100 yards from the junction B3020/A30.

BY RAIL...

There are frequent trains from London (Waterloo) and Reading to Ascot and Sunningdale. Inter-city and semi-fast services also run into Farnborough from the South west. Several taxi services operated from all these stations, taking approximately 15 minutes for the journey to the Lilly Research Centre.

BY AIR...

London Heathrow (35 minutes) and London Gatwick (60 minutes). Both these facilities are served by fast motorway links to the Research Centre at Bagshot.

THE CENTRE...

Eril Wood Manor was built in 1825-1826 by Sir Edmund Curry (nephew and son-in-law of George III) who was at the time the Controller of the Household of the Duke of Gloucester. Set in forty-seven acres of countryside, the house has been beautifully preserved and retains many decorative features of architectural interest with its panelled rooms and moulded pillars and ceilings. There are Adam-style fireplaces with unusual Wedgwood plaques and a grand staircase which sweeps down to the entrance hall. Since 1967 Eril Wood has functioned as Lilly Research Centre, and as such has served as a 'centre of excellence' for Lilly in the UK, dedicated to the discovery and development of breakthrough healthcare products.

NO SMOKING...
