


Ardley Energy Recovery Facility, Middleton Stoney Road, Oxfordshire, OX27 7AA

Please follow these instructions as they will help ensure your safety at our site.

On arrival

- Follow road markings as you approach site Drivers can use either inbound entry lane, in traffic use the right **inbound** lane.
- On green light drive forward, stop at the barrier and **remain in your vehicle** (no tailgating).
- Follow parking directions given by weighbridge staff.
- Stay on paths and marked crossings to walk safely to the reception.
- On rare occasions the priority lane has a queue, turn off your engine and phone the weighbridge operator on **01869 876 748**, they will instruct and assist.



Coach/Mini-bus Drop-off and Parking

Reverse park on either side of the bay outside the reception. Passengers should remain onboard until the group leader/responsible teacher has signed the group into the building or the visitor centre manager is present.



By Train: Take the train to either Bicester North or Bicester Town. Onward travel by taxi.



By Bus: Take the bus to Bicester. Onward travel by taxi.



By Bike: Cycles can be secured in the cycle shelter by reception.

Please follow these instructions as they will help ensure your safety at our site.

DO

- ✓ Stick to the site speed limit of 10mph
- ✓ Reverse park in Visitor Car Park
- ✓ Follow and stay on paths and marked crossings
- ✓ Go immediately to your reception point
- ✓ Be aware of traffic, keep clear of moving vehicles
- ✓ Do wear appropriate clothing for a visit to an industrial site

DO NOT

- ✗ Use a mobile phone whilst driving onsite
- ✗ Walk on the roadway
- ✗ Bring any children under the age of 8 to site
- ✗ Bring any pets to site
- ✗ Smoke or vape onsite except in designated areas
- ✗ Take pictures of the ERF without permission
- ✗ Do not have bare legs or arm
