Vienna offers a multitude of hotels, hostels and other types of accommodation that serve all tastes and all budgets.

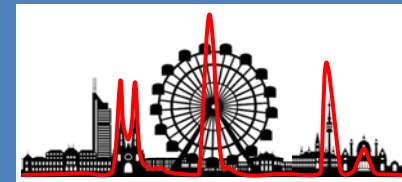
