

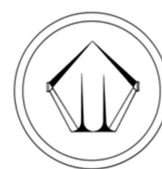
BIENNIAL NATIONAL ATOMIC SPECTROSCOPY SYMPOSIUM

A scientific symposium, where discussions will be held within the precinct of Strawberry Hill House, the Gothic Revival Villa built in 1749 by Horace Walpole, an 18th century leader of the “enlightenment.”

Topics include:

- Fundamentals of collision cells including triple quadrupole MS
- Measurement of nanoparticles (single particle and field-flow fractionation)
- Bioimaging and laser ablation applications
- Speciation and metallomics
- Biological and clinical applications of trace element analysis
- Environmental analysis
- Isotope ratio measurements

- Nanoparticle Analysis: using spICP-MS and FFF
