## Venue and Travel

The meeting will take place in GSK Weybridge.

### Directions

From M25 Junction 11 Chertsey

Follow the A317 to Weybridge and then the B374 signed for Weybridge Train Station. Take the road bridge across the railway then immediately turn left into St. George's Avenue. GlaxoSmithKline is approximately 200 metres on the right.

From M25 Junction 10 Wisley/A3 Cobham Exit

Take the A3 towards London and take the first slip road signed Cobham. At the roundabout take the first exit signed A245 Byfleet to the first roundabout. Take the B374 for approximately 2 miles to Weybridge Train Station. As turning right into St. George's Avenue is prohibited, you are obliged to continue across the railway bridge to the roundabout, return over the railway bridge and turn left into St. George's Avenue. GlaxoSmithKline is approximately 200 metres on the right.

From Walton-on-Thames Bridge

Follow the A3050 to Weybridge and then take the B374 to Weybridge Train Station. Take the road bridge across the railway then immediately turn left into St. George's Avenue. GlaxoSmithKline is approximately 200 metres on the right.

Via Train From London Waterloo to Weybridge

On average there are three trains an hour and the journey time is approximately 35 minutes. When you arrive, turn right out of Weybridge Train Station and walk over the railway bridge. Then turn directly left into St. George's Avenue and you will find GlaxoSmithKline is no more than 200 metres on the right.
