The Foresight Centre was formerly the third Liverpool Royal Infirmary, designed by Alfred Waterhouse with advice from Florence Nightingale.

After the AGM there will be a short presentation from Dr Amanda Boddis of Liverpool John Moores University. Amanda is a lecturer in Forensic Science. She has worked on techniques to detect drugs of abuse in latent fingerprints and to detect fingerprints on fabric. She will give a talk on recent advances in the chemical development and the detection of drugs in fingerprints.

A buffet starting at 6.15pm will be provided before the AGM.

If there is enough interest, a brief guided tour of the Centre should be available for those who arrive at 5.45pm.


