It's helpful to bring binoculars and field guides. Remember to pack a drink and a couple of sandwiches, as there are no refreshment facilities in the woods.

No special equipment is needed but the paths can be soggy and there is always a slight chance of rain, so waterproof walking boots/wellies and a raincoat may come handy.
