All delegates at the meeting, not just speakers, have the opportunity to make comments, ask questions, or present complementary or contradictory measurements and calculations during the discussion. If it is relevant to the topic, you may give a 5 minute presentation of your own work during the discussion. These remarks are published alongside the papers in the final volume and are fully citable. If you would like to present slides during the discussion please let the session chair know and load them onto the computer in the break before the start of the session.

Questions and comments from students and early career researchers are particularly encouraged. If you find it useful, please feel free to write your question down in advance.



Kansai International Airport (KIX) to Kyoto

After arriving at Kansai International Airport (KIX) there several options for travel 1. JR West train. 2. Limousine Bus. 3. Taxi.

1. Train

The Limited Express Haruka is the only rail service that takes you to Kyoto Station from KIX. It will take 1 hour and 15 minutes, after stopping at Shin-Osaka Station and Tennoji Station on the way.

At Kansai Airport Station, Haruka leaves from platform 4. See the map of Kansai Airport

The fare from Kansai Airport Station to Kyoto is JPY 2,850.

** For those staying at the ANA CROWNE PLAZA HOTEL the most recommended option travelling between KIX and Kyoto is the train. Also see below Kyoto Station to ANA CROWNE PLAZA HOTEL

2. Limousine Bus

Another option is the Limousine Bus. Regular services between Kansai Airport and Kyoto Station's Hachijoguchi southern exit , and there after stopping at several other destinations within the Kyoto city. This option may be more convenient for people whose hotel is close to one of the Limousine Bus stations.

The fare between KIX and Kyoto Station is JPY 2550, and it takes about 1 hr. 30 minutes.

3. Taxi

This will be the most expensive and time consuming travel from KIX to Kyoto, but taxi does operate early in the morning.

It is advised not to hail a taxi as this would be too expensive. If booked in advance two taxi companies have prices around JPY 3,500

Please check prices when booking as prices may have changed very recently.

It will take approximately 2 hrs30 minutes..

Kyoto Station to ANA CROWNE HOTEL

Train

There are two ways from Kyoto Station to ANA CROWNE HOTEL.

- 1) Kyoto Station to Nijo Station via JR Sagano Line and changing to Subway Tozai Line for one stop to get off at Nijojo-Mae Station, exit 2.
- 2) Kyoto Station to Karasuma Oike Station via Subway Karasuma Line and changing to Subway Tozai Line for one stop to get off at Nijojo-Mae Station, exit 2.

The hotel is few minutes' walk from the Nijojo-Mae Station.

Bus

Free Shuttle bus from Kyoto Station to ANA CROWNE HOTEL. Please check the map for the shuttle bus station.


To Ritsumeikan University Suzaku Campus

Ritsumeikan University Suzaku Campus is just 3 minute walk from Nijo Station.



Accommodation is **NOT** included in the registration fee; please arrange your own accommodation. Information on choice of nearby hotels is available on our [website](#).


Catering
