Introduction:

Water Quality 2012 offers a unique forum to discuss the many issues that affect the quality of water, from land management to water treatment processes. With a changing climate and growing global population, water resources will be under an enormous strain and it is important that water quality is maintained to ensure safe drinking water and water suitable for food production as well as considering the implications for the wider environment. This conference provides an opportunity to discuss current and emerging issues of relevance to global water resources.

Location:

The conference is hosted by Zhejiang University. Water Quality 2012 will take place at the JinXi Hotel & Conference Centre in Hangzhou, China. The hotel is situated close to the West Lake, a UNESCO World Heritage site, and Hangzhou city centre. The hotel is within easy reach of the railway station (8km) and airport (Hangzhou International Airport - 45km).

The conference is one of the most cost effective of its kind with delegate rates starting at ¥1000 including refreshments and lunch. Hotel accommodation is available at the conference venue.
