The George Hotel is situated at 19-21 George Street, in the 'New Town' area of Edinburgh www.EdinburghGeorgeHotel.co.uk
George Street is parallel to Princes Street and a short walking distance from the railway station. If arriving at Edinburgh airport there is a regular bus service into the city centre and taxis available. George Street has metered parking; the nearest car park is the NCP St. James Centre on Elder Street or Leith Street.
