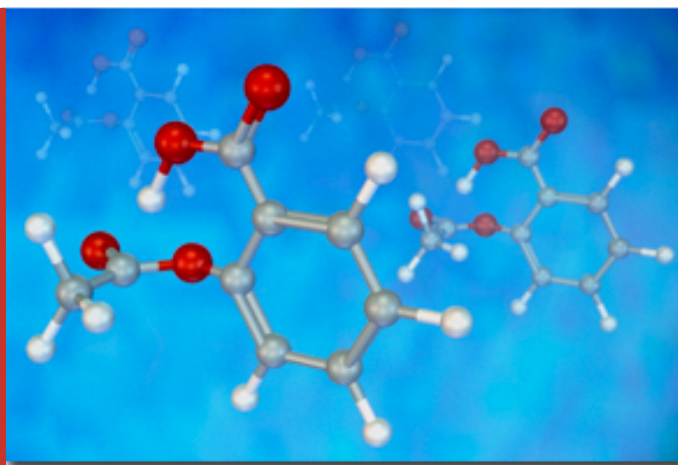

First call for graduate students to apply to give oral presentations & posters and register to attend the BMCS symposium

The **Biological and Medicinal Chemistry Sector** (BMCS) of the RSC is organising a postgraduate symposium for PhD and postdoctoral students working in biological or medicinal chemistry, chemical biology or related areas. The event will be held in the Department of Chemistry at the University of Cambridge on **Thursday 29th November 2007**. Students working in these areas from any UK university are invited to participate and/or register to attend – but places are strictly limited. Registration will start from 9:00 am with talks beginning at 10 am. The day will consist of nine oral presentations (6 student and 3 industrial). Each 20-minute student talk will be followed by 10 minutes for questions.

Please download and complete the registration form from www-medchem.ch.cam.ac.uk and send it by email. Please add "REGISTRATION BMCS SYMPOSIUM" to the subject otherwise the email will be deleted.

Throughout the day there will be keynote talks on drug discovery and development from industrial chemists. A buffet lunch will be provided to accompany the poster session. The BMCS judges will be awarding prizes to participants. There will be one prize of **£250** for the best oral presentation and a prize of **£100** for the best poster. These will be celebrated at the end of the day.

If you are interested in presenting your relevant PhD or post-doctoral work please submit a half-page abstract by **31st October 2007** along with your registration form. Those selected by the BMCS committee to give oral presentations will be notified by 15th November. Travel expenses will be reimbursed to speakers.

There will be **NO CHARGE** to attend the event but all attendees are required to register as soon as possible and no later than by **Friday 23rd November**.
