Young Researchers Meeting YR2012

at Ramada Encore Hotel, Warrington**

The Radiochemistry Group is once again pleased to encourage young scientists in the field of radiochemistry, through the informal and friendly atmosphere of the 'Young Researchers Meeting'. It is designed as a forum for the exchange of ideas and experiences between researchers in industry, research institutes and university departments. Researchers under 35 are encouraged to submit abstracts on topics in the field of chemistry of the radionuclides. Due to the popularity of the event it will now be held over two days. The deadline for submission of abstracts is the 16th March 2012.

A prize will be awarded for the best talk of the day, based on the quality of the presentation. Speakers are given 15 minutes for their presentation with 5 minutes for questions. The winner will receive a cheque for £150 and the honour of having her/his name added to those of previous recipients on the coveted trophy, a bust of Marie Curie, which will remain in her/his possession until the next meeting. A cheque for £75 will be awarded to the runner-up. The winner will also be funded to present his/her research at an appropriate scientific conference, up to the value of £500.

At the last meeting in 2010 the Marie Curie Trophy was awarded to Sarah Wallace Lloyd from the University of Leeds. The title of Sarah's presentation was 'The behaviour of strontium-90 in contaminated land associated with former UK nuclear sites'.

The YR2012 meeting is being hosted by AMEC at Ramada Encore Hotel, Warrington. Supervisors are also welcome to attend and support their students. Full directions for both drivers and those using public transport will be supplied as required.

To register your interest in the meeting, please return the application form as soon as possible. There is no charge for attending this meeting, lunch is provided and students may claim travel costs from the Radiochemistry Group of the Royal Society of Chemistry. Funding is also available for academics bringing their research students to the meeting.
