

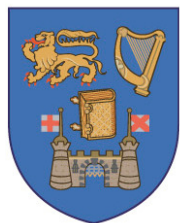
# Photochemistry and Photochemical Techniques

The traditional field of photochemistry is now the basis for diverse modern-day applications in areas such as solar energy conversion, electronics, sensors, nanotechnology, biology and medicine. The experimental techniques used to study the interaction of light with matter have also become ever more sophisticated, operating on faster timescales and with improved spatial resolution. This two-day meeting aims to celebrate the advances being made in Photochemistry and Photochemical Techniques and provide insight into the further developments needed.

Due to the unforeseen visit of HRH Queen Elizabeth II to Trinity College Dublin on the 16th/17th May 2011 (the last British Monarch to visit Ireland was the Queen's grandfather King George VI!) the meeting will now take place between University College Dublin (UCD) and Trinity College Dublin (TCD).
