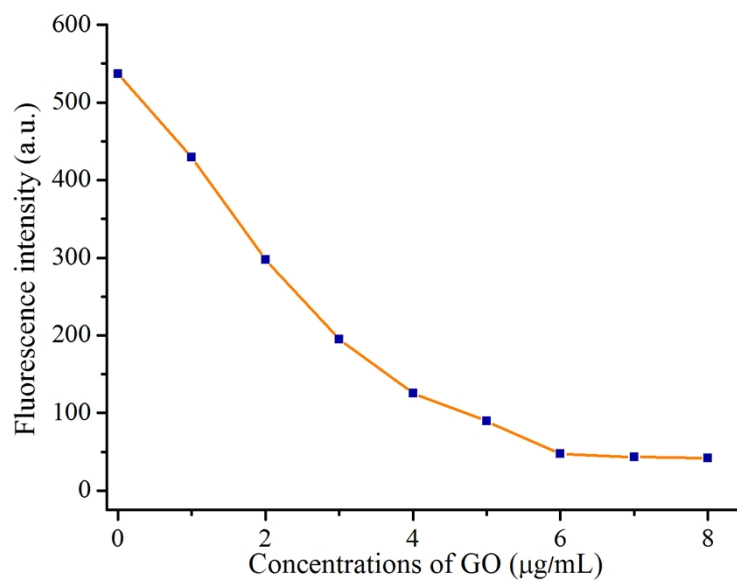


Fig. S1 Fluorescence intensity of DP (250 nM) after addition of GO with different concentrations.

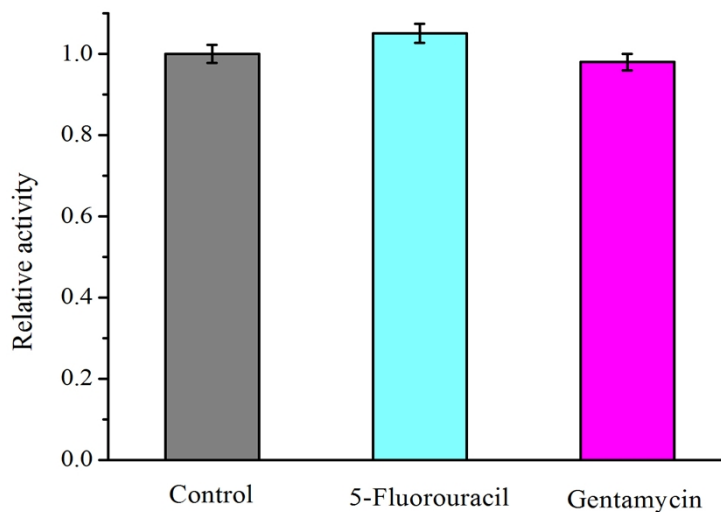


Fig. S2 Influence of 5-fluorouracil and gentamycin on the activity of T7 Exo. The concentration for each drug was 100 µM.
