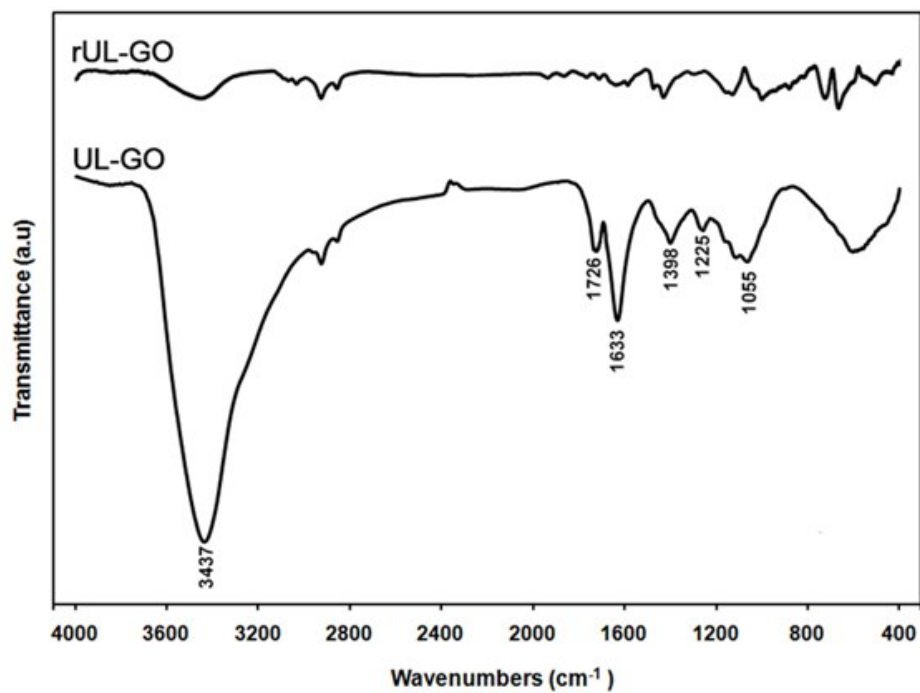


Fig. S1 FTIR spectra of UL-GO and rUL-GO.

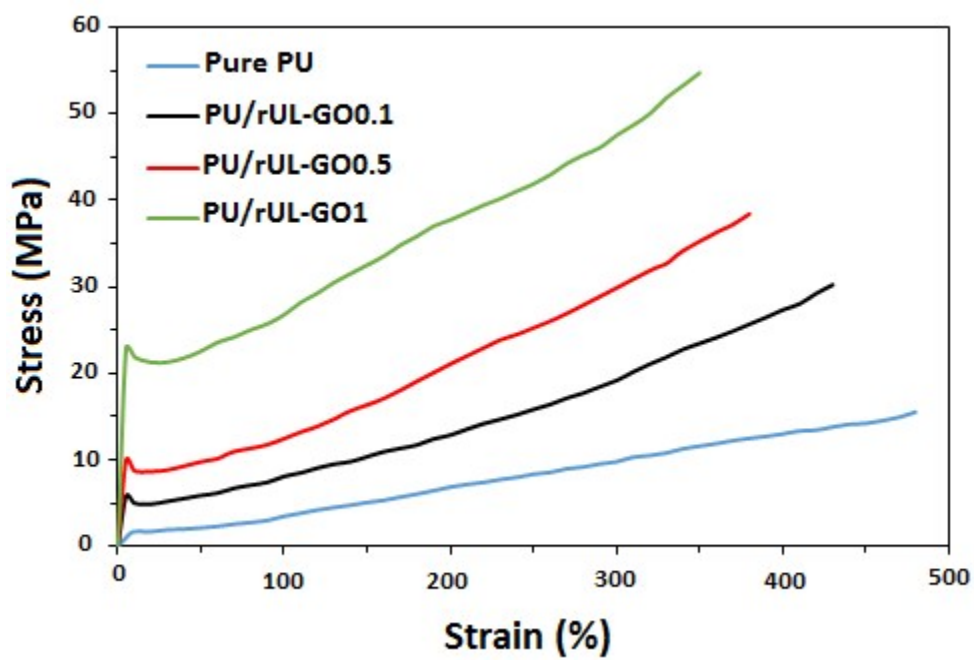


Fig. S2 Stress-strain curves of pure PU and PU/rUL-GO composite foams.
