


Fig. S1 LSV curves of NG/Co-NS with rotation speed range from 500 to 2500 rpm min⁻

Fig. S2 The LSV curves of different catalysts modified air-cathode in real MFCs.




Fig. S3 The resistance distribution (insert picture is the characteristic equivalent electrocircuit) of different catalysts modified air-cathode MFCs.
