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


Figure S1. The adsorption-desorption equilibrium curves before light irradiation.




Figure S2. The cycling experiment of the 3.0 P-BOC for degradation of RhB.




Figure S3. XPS spectra of the 3.0 P-BOC before and after degradation of RhB.
