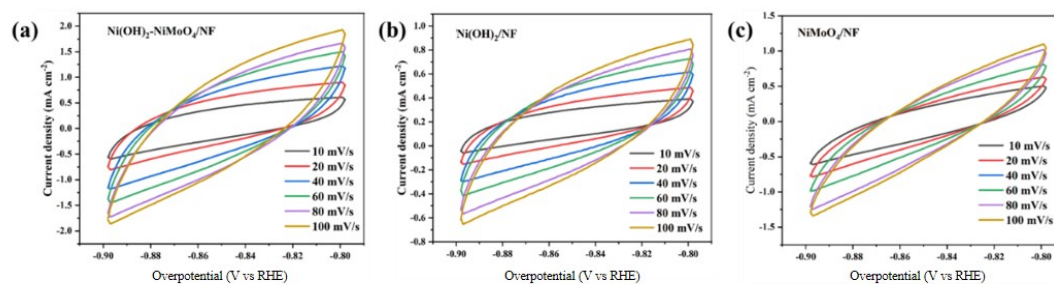

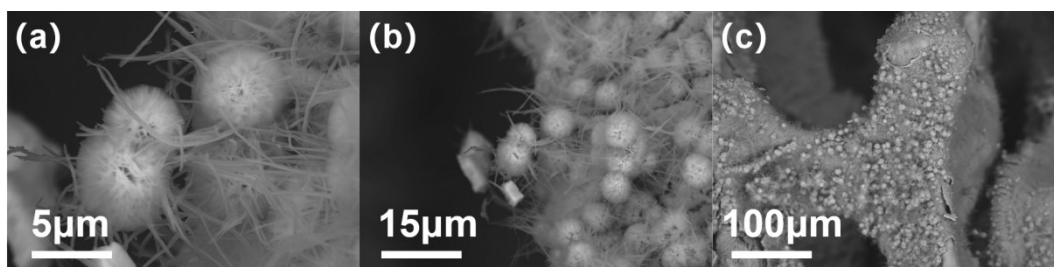


Figure S2. SEM images of Ni(OH)<sub>2</sub>-NiMoO<sub>4</sub>/NF after stability test.
