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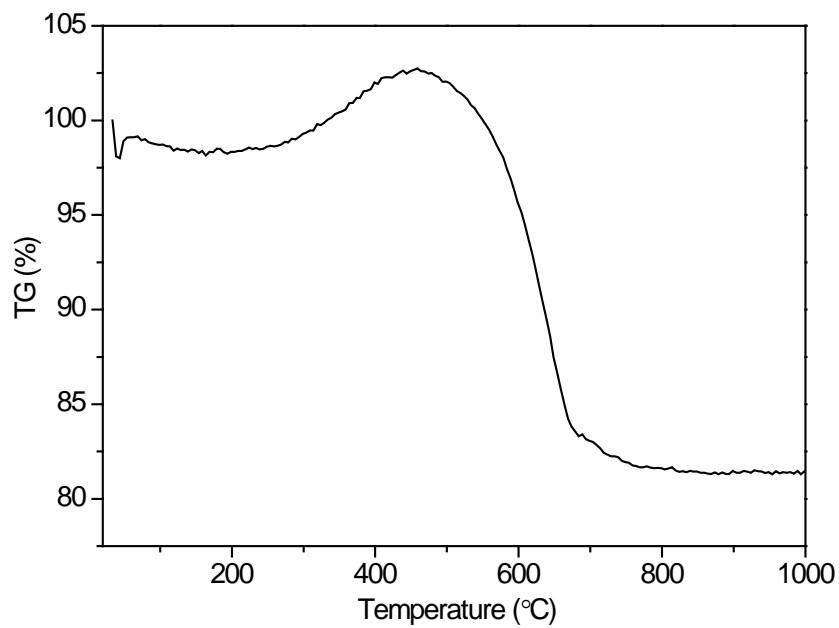


Fig. S1. Thermogravimetry (TG) curve of OMSCM prepared at 1200 °C in an air flow (10 °C/min).

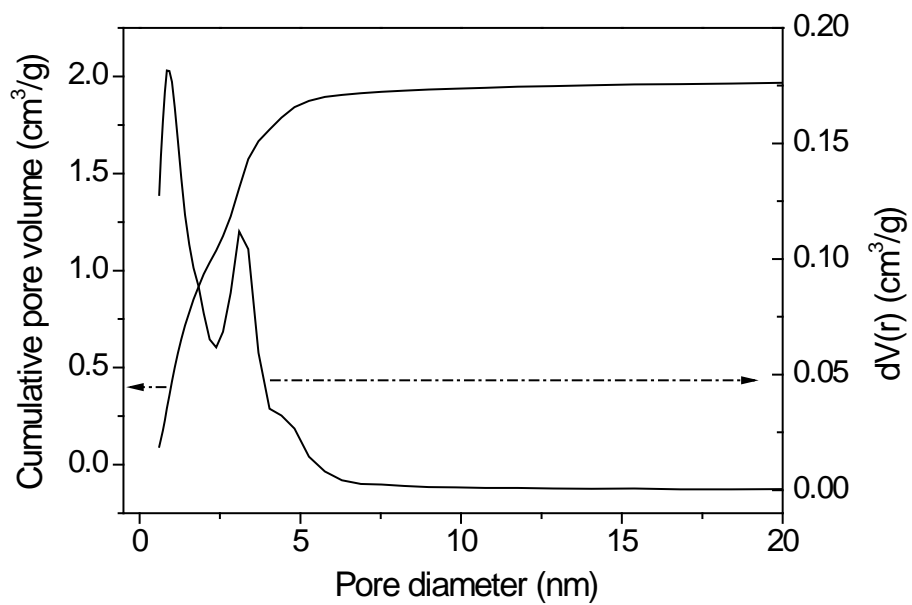


Fig. S2. Cumulative pore volume and pore size distribution of the HPCDCM.
