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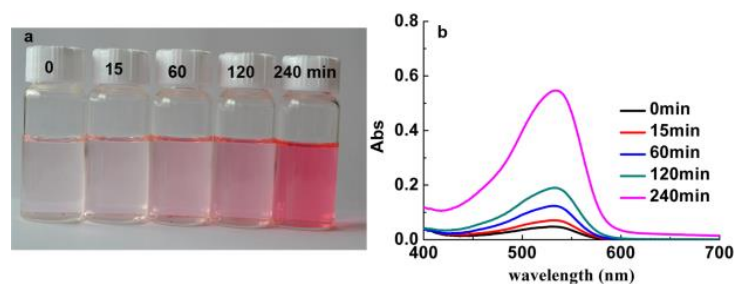

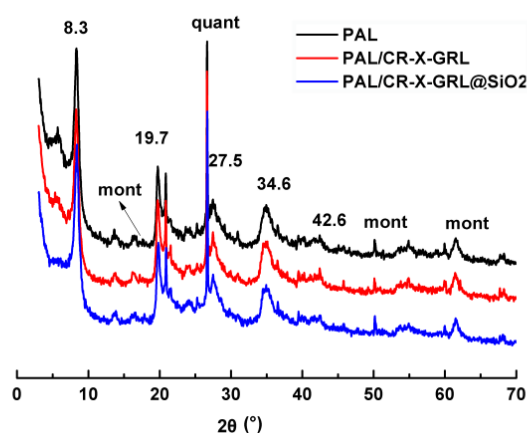


Fig. S2. XRD patterns of PAL, PAL/CR-X-GRL and PAL/CR-X-GRL@SiO₂.
